You have entered a class that will cover three different Web development programs from the **Adobe CS4 Web Standard Suite**, therefore, it is very important to follow the syllabus and course guide found on your homework sheets. If you do not finish all of the assignments outside of the textbook, it's okay, just move on. You can always go back at a later date to attempt to finish them. However, it is very important to do the five projects each week, they build upon each other for the following weeks work.

That means all textbook exercises must be completed on time for grading, these are firm dates; I've chosen very short exercises that are very well covered in your chapters reading. In most cases you'll find that a lot of the leg-work has been done for you if it is not necessary for the lesson being taught in the current chapter. These exercises are not advanced projects, but geared to the beginner in Web Design; therefore, a careful reading of the chapter will be of great use to you.

This class is a hybrid version which means there are several nights that you'll be on campus for a lecture period. Look in **Moodle** for the **Topic** of the **Lecture Night** on Campus. The lecture room is also equipped with PC computers so expect some hands-on activity as well. Special nights not to miss if you are new to this material.

The **Prof. Al Exercises** found in Moodle are my original exercises updated to the CS4 version of Dreamweaver, but can be accomplished in most prior versions of the software. For these exercises, the more you do the more you learn how to do. Do the lion's share of these exercises and not only will you know enough to be dangerous, but will walk out of this class with top honors.

Note: I have given you more time to complete as many of these exercises as you can do in the weeks allotted, however, they need to be turned in on or before **Oct 04** so we can begin our studies of **Fireworks CS4**.

I would prefer that you turn them in as soon as you do them; I will strive to grade them in a timely manner. These exercises will add to your final score in this class, so don't ignore them completely.
